1. Policy Statement

1.1. To support our children to show respect through our appearance, have high aspirations by setting an appropriate tone for learning, and to achieve as part of a team, we have developed the uniform policy following consultation with our parents and carers, staff and whole school community.

2. School uniform

- *Branded items**
- Burford Primary School branded dark blue crew neck sweatshirt or cardigan.
- Burford Primary School branded V-neck, dark blue sweatshirt or cardigan for Year 6 only.
- *Non-branded items*
- Red polo shirt.
- Dark (black or grey) trousers, shorts or skirt.
- Gingham dress – red and white check.
- If wearing tights, they should be dark (black or grey)
- If wearing long socks, they should be white.
- Plain, black shoes which should be suitable for running around in – no heeled boots or sandals.

- Year 6 children – plain white shirt and tie

PE Kit

- Plain navy t shirt
- Plain black or navy shorts or tracksuit bottoms (some subtle branding is acceptable)
- Plain black or navy jumper or hoody
- Trainers for outdoor use

3. Other items

- Branded book bags (only available from Mapac)*
- Wellington boots
- Water bottle
- Coat
- Hat
- Gloves and scarf
- Sun cream (children should apply themselves)
- Waterproof trousers (optional)

Please note:

4. Jewellery

- Watch – preferably analogue to support reading the time. No smart watches or watches with cameras or games. Basic activity trackers are allowed.
- Small stud earrings (these must be removed for PE. If your child is unable to remove their earrings, then you will need to provide them with micropore tape or plasters to cover their earrings).
- No other jewellery, such as rings or bracelets, are allowed.

5. General appearance

- Long hair should be tied back. This is essential for PE.
- No make-up should be worn
- No nail polish or temporary tattoos should be visible.
